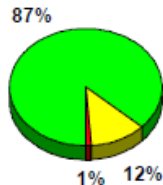
2. Decline in U.S. Career Missionaries

Giving to Foreign Missions for work among people that live within reach of the Gospel but haven't responded	12%
Giving to Foreign Missions for work among unreached people groups.	1%
